Fishing Regulations

Kalamazoo River is stocked with rainbow trout/steelhead and brown trout, and the river gets a late fall run of lake trout. Kalamazoo River in this section is not designated as a trout stream. Regulations for Streams Not Classified as Stream Type or Listed as a Gear Restricted Stream regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

Saugatuck Harbor is the direct access location to the navigational channel in Kalamazoo River with access to Lake Michigan. There is a one lane boat launch, but parking is limited to city streets and availability during busy summer tourism. The access site is owned by the City of Saugatuck and the habor is located at the intersection of Water Street and Spear Street.
