Species Description

Rainbow Trout are stocked in Ackerman Lake annually. Rainbow Trout grow well in Ackerman Lake and reach sizes up to 20 inches with most fish caught between 11 and 15 inches. Summer night time fishing is popular with a lantern, while winter time anglers fish through the ice with good success.

Noteworthy

This is a beautiful lake to just paddle around and/or fish. A hiking trail is also accessible at this location for those seeking a little fresh "UP" air. Most anglers fishing here will use minnows targeting the thermocline during the warm months and hitting the shallows during the winter. Ackerman Lake has a maximum depth of about 50 feet. The best location to target fish is off of the roadway at the thermocline.

Fishing Regulations

Ackerman Lake is a designated Type B trout lake. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Lake Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

Ackerman Lake is located southwest of Munising. Leaving Munising, follow M-94 about 9.2 miles to Ackerman Lake access on the left-hand side of the road (lake visible from road). Make left into the access drive to boat launch. The boat launch is unimproved so a carry-in/car topper would be best suited here.
