Brown Trout; Rainbow Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

Brown trout are the primary species encountered at this location. Rainbow trout are also available and migratory steelhead can be found here in the early spring and late fall. The river here is somewhat shallow, with good gravel and woody debris present throughout. Natural reproduction occurs at this location for brown trout and rainbow trout. Steelhead are stocked at the Platte River State Fish Hatchery each spring.

Noteworthy

The Platte River at Veterans Park is a popular yet rustic fishing spot just downstream of the Platte River State Fish Hatchery. This access site offers a Forest Resources Division rustic campground with 24 campsites situated within a short distance from the river, and much of the surrounding area is State land.

Fishing Regulations

The Platte River at Veterans Park is designated a Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the village of Honor stay on US-31 heading east toward Traverse City. After approximately two miles the Veterans Park Campground will be on the right hand side of the road. The entrance is just before the bridge over the river.
