Species Description

Lake Michigan spawning runs of steelhead and Chinook salmon. Stocked brown and rainbow trout.

Noteworthy

teelhead fishing occurs from late October through June and Chinook salmon during September and October. Brown trout and rainbow trout fishing occurs all year. Fishing occurs from small boats and wading from the shoreline. Bait, lodging and food available in nearby Muskegon, Fremont and Newaygo.

Fishing Regulations

The Muskegon River below Bridge Street is designated a Type 3 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of M-37 and M-82 on the south side of Newaygo, travel north on M-37 for 1 mile to Bridge Street, then head west 0.2 miles (crossing over the river) to Sarell Street, then left one block to the access site.
