Lake Michigan spawning runs of steelhead and Chinook salmon. Brown trout and rainbow trout are stocked.

Noteworthy

Steelhead fishing occurs from late October through June and Chinook salmon during September and October. Brown trout and rainbow trout fishing occurs all year. Fishing is best from small boats or wading from the shoreline. Bait, lodging and food available in nearby Muskegon, Fremont and Newaygo.

Fishing Regulations

The Muskegon River in this area is designated a Type 4 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of M-37 and M-82 (Croton Drive) on the north side of Newaygo, on Croton Drive travel east 0.4 miles to Henning Park.
