Lake Michigan spawning runs of steelhead and Chinook salmon. Stocked rainbow and brown trout.

Noteworthy

Steelhead fishing occurs from late October through June and Chinook salmon during September and October. Brown trout and rainbow trout fishing occurs all year. Fishing is best by wading from the shoreline. Bait, lodging and food available in nearby Muskegon, Fremont and Newaygo.

Fishing Regulations

The Muskegon River in this area is designated a Type 4 trout stream upstream (above) from Bridge Street and a Type 4 trout stream downstream (below) Bridge Street. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in your current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of M-37 and M-82 on the south side of Newaygo, travel on M-37 north for 1 mile to Bridge Street, then left (west) two blocks to the City Park.
