Noteworthy

Steelhead fishing occurs from late October through May, brown trout from late October through mid-December, and Chinook salmon during September and October. Fishing is best primarily from small boats. Bait, lodging and food available in nearby Muskegon.

Fishing Regulations

The Muskegon River in this area is designated a Type 3 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of US-31 and M-46 (Apple Avenue) in Muskegon, travel on M-46 east for 1 mile to Sheridan Road, then north 1.8 miles to the access site at the river.
