Brook trout are the primary trout species encountered at this location. These fish will be mostly 7-10 inches in length with fish 10-13 inches occasionally found in the area.

The USFS-Hiawatha National Forest owns the area around the Fishdam River. Trout can be found throughout the area but particularly in areas where habitat has been enhanced by the USFS.

Fishing Regulations

Directions to Site

From the junction of US-2 and Forest Highway 13, travel north on Forest Highway 13 for approximately 8.1 miles to County Road 442. Turn right (east) and travel on County Road 442 for approximately 5.5 miles to where the Fishdam River crosses the road. There is also a two-track found to the south of County Road 442 that can be used for access along the Fishdam River.
