Species Description

Yearling brook trout are stocked annually. Anglers report good catches of brook trout with sizes ranging from seven to ten inches. Not many big fish have been reported.

Noteworthy

Wading is difficult making bank or boat angling the primary approach here. Anglers who want to float with a canoe or kayak can access off of Foley Hill Road bridge or the CR 363 bridge. Most anglers use natural bait and anglers that fish farthest from the bridge have better success.

Fishing Regulations

The West Branch Teaspon Creek ad the CR 363 bridge is a designated Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

This site is southwest of the village of Newberry. Follow M-123 south 3.5 miles to M-28 and turn right (west). Follow M-28 for one mile to county (CR) 363 and turn right (north). The second bridge crossing is a quarter mile from M-28 for access to the creek.
