Fishing Regulations

The area of the Driggs River at M-28 has split regulation types. Upstream from the M-28 bridge the Driggs River and tributaries are designated as a Research Area (RA) where Type 1 regulations apply, EXCEPT 5 additional Brook Trout may be retained as part of the daily possession limit. Downstream from the M-28 bridge is designated a Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of M-94 and M-28 in Shingleton, travel east on M-28 for approximately 16.4 miles. Access the river by using the right-of-way along the road and bridge.
