The Fox River is noted for its wild brook trout fishery and it is managed as a "Natural River".

Fishing Regulations

The area of the Fox River at the Fox River State Forest Campground has split regulations. Upstream from the M-28 bridge to the Fox River State Forest Campground, the Fox River is designated as a Gear Restricted (GR) trout stream. Upstream of the Fox River State Forest Campground the Fox River is designated as a Type 1 trout stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of M-28 and M-77 in Seney, travel west on M-28 for approximately 0.3 miles and turn right on School Street (will turn into Fox River Road). Travel on School Street (Fox River Road) for approximately 6 miles. The Fox River State Forest Campground will be on the right (east) side of the road.
