Wild brook and brown trout are both present here. Brook trout up to ten inches are common and brown trout can grow to twenty inches or larger in this reach.

Noteworthy

Cobble, gravel and sand bottom are all present here. The Mason Tract Pathway parallels the river in this area and provides multiple access points. The parking lot offers room for two to three vehicles and this site is in the Mason Tract of State forest land.
