Species Description

Wild brook and brown trout are both present here. Brook trout up to 10 inches are common and brown trout grow to 20 inches or larger in this reach.

Noteworthy

Cobble, gravel and sand substrate are all present here. A moderate walk of about 5 to 10 minutes from the parking lot takes you to the river through a lowland spruce and cedar swamp. This site is in the Mason Tract of State forest land.

Fishing Regulations

The South Branch Au Sable River at The Swamp is a designated Gear Restricted Stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From Roscommon, take M-18 north/northeast to Chase Bridge Road and turn left (north). Continue on Chase Bridge road for about 2.3 miles to Mason Tract Trail (gravel road) and turn right (east). Continue on the Mason Tract Trail for about 1.8 miles and then turn right. The parking area is about a 1/3 of a mile down a dirt road.
