Species Description

Wild brook and brown trout are both present here. Brook trout up to 9 inches are common and brown trout can grow to 20 inches or larger in this reach.

Noteworthy

Cobble, gravel and sand holes are all present here. There is also a fair amount of wood in the stream. Wading is generally pretty easy but there are some deep holes to be aware of. This is on State land but anglers should be aware of some private property.
