Species Description

Wild brook trout up to 12 inches and wild brown trout to 20 inches are found here.

Noteworthy

The river is about a 300 yard walk to the south of the parking area and there are several paths that take you to the river. Make sure to stay on State land when trying to access the river. This is a remote side and the trek to the river can be difficult going through woods and lowland.

Fishing Regulations

The North Branch Au Sable River at State Land is a designated Gear Restricted stream. Please refer to the Inland Trout and Salmon Stream Regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

Directions to Site

From the intersection of Lovells Road and County Road (CR) 612 go west for about a third of a mile on CR 612. Turn left on Bald Hill road and continue for about 2.4 miles. At the fork in the road, keep left and drive for .8 miles, keep right onto Hi Banks Road. Take the third two-track after High Banks Lodge and drive for just under a mile to the parking area.
