Brown Trout; Rainbow Trout

Species Description

Some wild brown trout are present at this location and both rainbow trout and brown trout are stocked throughout the general reach of this river. This is one of 8 direct stocking locations annually by DNR. Catches of brown trout typically range from 7-18 inches, but some fish can approach 25 inches. Rainbow trout are typically age 1 fish ranging from 7-10 inches, with occasional fish up to 16 inches caught. Wading water is available and anglers should use caution. Good presentations to use are dry flies, nymphs, spinners and crankbaits. Parking is available in this forest road ending. This is USFS property, so federal laws apply to land.
