Fish Species

Brown Trout; Rainbow Trout

Species Description

Some wild brown trout are present and both rainbow trout and brown trout are also stocked. This is one of 8 stocking locations for this reach of river. Brown trout typically range from 7-18 inches, but some fish can approach 25 inches. Rainbow trout are typically age 1 fish that range from 7-10 inches, with occasional fish up to 16 inches caught.

Noteworthy

Wading water is limited but available, and anglers should use caution. Good presentations to use are dry flies, nymphs, spinners and crankbaits. Parking is available for multiple vehicles. This is a good location to launch or retrieve a drift boat or canoe.

Fishing Regulations

This is a Gear Restricted Stream. These regulations apply to the site, including upstream of landing, and downstream of landing to bridge. Regulations are different downstream of bridge. Directions to Site

From the junction of Evans Road and County Road 600 (F32) in the town of McKinley, take Evans Road south approximately a quarter mile to access site on the west side of bridge.
