

Carp River At Powerline



Fish Species

Brook Trout; Brown Trout; Steelhead

Species Description

Although you may get an occasional brown trout or brook trout, most trout caught here will be steelhead. Some steelhead are stocked in the Carp River each year, but there is also natural reproduction (wild fish). In the fall, you might also catch some Chinook, coho or pink salmon.

Noteworthy

The river is approximately 30-40 feet wide here and can have good current. Depths are 2-3 feet deep. Gravel substrate upstream. Easiest to park at Forest Road 3118 and walk to the river (less than 0.5 mile).

Directions to Site

From Mackinac Trail, take Red Creek Road (FR 3118/Red Creek Road) to the south/west to Powerline Crossing. Park at the road and walk the powerline north to the river.
