This part of the river has wild brook trout up to 12 inches, steelhead (juveniles to 8 inches and adults) and coho salmon.

Noteworthy

This section of the North Branch Carp has unique geology, with areas of bedrock, boulders and gravel. Although it has the traditional trout season regulations, adult steelhead are sometimes still present when the season opens in the spring. Brook trout are also present. Water levels are variable depending on rain/snowmelt, as there is very little groundwater here. Fly fishing is difficult due to overhanging tag alders.
