Species Description

Some wild brown trout are present here and both rainbow trout and brown trout are stocked. This is one of 8 stocking locations for this reach of river. Brown trout typically range from 7-18 inches, but some fish can approach 25 inches. Rainbow trout, typically age 1 fish, range from 7-10 inches, with occasional fish up to 16 inches caught.

Noteworthy

Wading water is limited but available, and anglers should use caution. Good presentations to use are dry flies, nymphs, spinners and crankbaits. This is U.S. Forest Service property, federal laws apply. Very scenic location, and good one to launch or retrieve canoes.
