Species Description

This is a remote walk-in lake that is stocked with various species of trout annually by the MDNR. Typical trout caught are 7-15 inches in length but some larger fish may be present if broodstock trout are stocked on occasion at this location.

Best presentations are flies, spinners or jigs. Fishing best accomplished with a portable float tube. Open all year to fishing and harvest. All tackle types may be used.

Directions to Site

In the town of Glennie, take M-65 Highway north approximately 6 miles to M-72 Highway, then take a right (east). Drive approximately 3 miles to the Reid Lake forest service hiking trailhead sign. Park at the lot, and hike in to the lake for approximately 1.5 miles.
