Directions to Site

Turn Left (West) Off Forest Hwy 13, onto County Road 440. Proceed 1 mile and turn Right (North) onto USFS Road 2269. Proceed 2.0 miles and turn Left (West) onto two-track. Proceed 0.75 miles and stop. Proceed 1/3 mile to Brian's Pond on foot up over hill in a westerly direction.
