Noteworthy

Rock Lake is 10 acre lake located within the Hiawatha National Forest. Rock Lake has been managed for Brook Trout for more than 50 years. Rock Lake, along with nearby Hike and Bette's Pond, is a Type A regulated trout lake which provides anglers trout fishing opportunities from the last Saturday in April to September 30th. Watercraft use in Rock Lake is limited to small boats, canoes, for float tubes that can be carried in.

Directions to Site

Turn North off US-2 onto Forest Highway 13. Proceed 28.2 miles and turn Left on to Forest Rd 2254 (Blacktop). Proceed 0.9 miles to junction. Turn Left onto Forest Rd 2268. Proceed 1.4 miles, turn Left on two-track, Proceed 1 .2 miles turn Left on two-track Proceed 0.1 miles to Rock Lake.
