TAGGING FISH IN PERE MARQUETTE AND SABLE RIVERS BY MASON COUNTY CHAPTER, IZAAK WALTON LEAGUE OF AMERICA

We are informed by Harold P. Miller of Ludington, Secretary of the Mason County Chapter, Izaak Walton League of America, that "during the spring run in the Sable River, the local Ikes trap fish below the dam and transport them in tubs to the water above. Stolberg obtained clios at the First National Bank and many of these fish were thus tagged. From above the dam, through Hamlin Lake, the fish have access to the Sable River, which flows through Freesoil. Without doubt, Mr. Grinnell caught one of these; which pleases us immensely".

This report follows from an inquiry we made to learn the source of a trout caught in the Sable River with a paper clip on its gill cover. The correspondence regarding this fish was forwarded early this season from Lansing.

Mr. Miller furnishes also a list of stream trout tagged by him during his fishing in June on the Pere Marquette River. This list is appended hereto.
