LAKE NAMES

Anyone having occasion to use the names of Michigan lakes must certainly realize the difficulties arising from duplication, misspelling, absence of authorized names and synonyms. As a matter of fact so much confusion exists in our present lake nomenclature that save in a few instances it is not safe to cite a lake by name alone. I think of the plight of a fisherman not too well acquainted with the region of northern Washtenaw and southern Livingston Counties who has just arrived in the vicinity of Whitmore Lake and who by previous invitation was to meet some friends at Silver Lake.

When he asks his way he is immediately confronted with, "What Silver Lake are you looking for? There are three within 10 miles of here. Is it the Silver in Green Oak Township or Hamburg Silver or Big Silver over west of here?" Of course the fisherman doesn't know and so he spends the rest of his precious day systematically canvassing the Silver Lakes of the region. This is not an exaggerated example.

Some lake names are duplicated several times within a single county. The name Silver refers to at least 27 different lakes in 22 different counties. Five counties have two Silver Lakes and Cheboygan County has three. A number of duplications of names even within townships have come to our attention.

What is the reason for this state of affairs? Obviously the present names of lakes are the result of a long time chance system with little or no direction or control. It is true of course today that names used on federal maps must meet the requirements of the U. S. Geographic Board. Unfortunately the agencies preparing state maps are not guided by any uniform system or code. Many errors are passed on from one generation of maps to another. These erroneous names are perpetuated and multiplied almost in proportion to the number of editions or revisions that a map has gone through.

Misspellings are exceedingly numerous. Several hundred questionable spellings were found in the course of preparing the name list at the end of this report. The task of determining the proper spelling would require a study into the origin of each name. A certain lake in Kalamazoo County is spelled "Hogset" on some maps and "Hogshead" on others. Floyd Lake of Iosco County, so named on older maps, is labeled Loyd Lake on more recent editions. In Branch County "Sprung" Lake is shown as "Sprong" Lake on some maps. Harrideane, Harringdeane, and Haringdean are three spellings for the name of one lake in Benzie County as are Moner's, Moher's, and Marrs for a single lake in Lenawee County. Valley and Volley, Pogie and Pogy, Juday and Judy, Poss and Ross, Cogger and Logger, Decou and Decoy are all examples of misspellings but don't ask me which spelling is right. In the case of Sassafras Lake spelled "Sassifrass" on several recent maps there is little question that the first spelling is correct because it is almost certain that the lake was named for the Sassafras tree.

There is little doubt that most of our lake names were assigned without thought of duplication but not without reason. If the history of these
names was complete what an interesting chapter it would make. The reason
for the application of certain names is more or less obvious. A surveyor

in his traversing noted a lake in section 27 of a certain township and because of this reference the lake was called 27. The allotment of certain sections of state land for school purposes gave rise to the names of School Section. School or School Lot for the lakes on these tracts.

The "chance system" of naming lakes has resulted in duplication and confusion for many names but it also has given us a lot of good names. As a matter of fact many of our most picturesque and desirable names originated in just this way. I am reminded of an example which illustrates this point. A sawmill once stood on the shores of a lake in Mecosta County. One day near the close of lumbering operations in that district, the steam boiler of the mill exploded with a "boom" that was heard for miles around. The sawmill was never rebuilt. The lake where this mishap occurred has been known as Boom Lake since that time. A name with such heritage should never be changed.

Without doubt, the most common lake names are those of men who either by their greatness, ownership or politics have had their names applied to lakes. No one denies the desirability of applying the names of illustrious people to geographic features, but it is highly undesirable that politics or wealth should play any part in this selection. It is safe to say that more than one half of the lake names now appearing on state maps have been derived from the names of people.

The most duplicated lake names however are of a descriptive nature. Mud lakes greatly surpass all others in abundance. A total of 262 mud lakes in 61 different counties of Michigan were found on the maps, not counting those prefixed by big or little. There are no doubt many other small lakes known locally by this name but which are not shown as such on our maps. Barry County has 12, Marquette 10, and Ogemaw and Jackson 9 each. Twenty-three counties have 5 or more Mud lakes. It is true that

many of the Mud lakes are not of much value to fisheries or for other recreational uses. The name "Mud" has been applied to the majority of nearly extinct, weed-filled or muddy bottom lakes of small size. Not all Mud lakes are of this character however and if they were there is little excuse for duplication of this sort.

Long Lakes are next in abundance; there being 84 shown on state and county maps and Twin is a close third with 79. A list of those names used twenty or more times follows:

The popularity of the names of animals and plants as lake names can be seen from the above list. Pickerel, Bass, Perch, Bullhead and Trout are the most common fish names used. Duck and Loon top the list of bird names while Bear and Deer are the most popular names of game animals.

It is not possible in this report to further classify or delve into the history of our lake names. Since only fragmentary information exists on the subject, an investigation of this origin of lake names would entail a great deal of time and study.

The main concern at present is to encourage name changes for lakes where excessive duplication exists and the proper naming of the small lakes which are now without well established names. The number of lakes of all sizes in Michigan as shown on the most reliable maps is 11037. A total of all the different names used is approximately 3500 and there are about 4700 lakes without adequate names. This means that approximately 3000 lakes in Michigan have duplicate names.

An alphabetical list of lake names compiled from all of our maps and records is attached to this report. This was a tedious and time consuming task accomplished mainly through the efforts of Mrs. Grace Wood and Miss Madeline Klaphaak.

This list includes some synonyms because it was not possible to determine the most acceptable name for certain lakes having two or more names. Of course, all names were dropped which have been superseded by names accepted by the National Geographic Board. We made no attempt to correct the misspelled names on the map unless there was good authority for doing so.

Those in a position to guide and advise regarding name changes should find the list very useful—particularily if it is kept up to date as official changes occur. It certainly should be an aid in preventing future duplications and encourage the reduction of those already in existence.

Name Changes

There are two principal prerequisites of a good lake name:

(1) It should be distinctive—duplication ought to be avoided. (2) It should be pronounceable and of reasonable length. Even official distinctive names will not persist if they cannot be pronounced. Indian names made up of many syllables separated by hyphens are not desirable. It is physically impossible to find room for such names on reduced maps. Drafts—men will invariably find it necessary to leave out all hyphens and then the name cannot be pronounced without much difficulty. I do not wish to discourage the use of a reasonable number of short Indian names but excessive use of such names does not seem practical or desirable.

The policy of following the rules laid down by the National Geographic Board is very desirable because it makes all name changes eligible for official federal maps. Mimeographed instructions are available from Dr. R. A. Smith, chief of the Geology Division and chairman of the State Committee on Geographic Names. A copy of these instructions follows:

PROCEDURE FOR OFFICIALLY CHANGING NAMES

LAKES, RIVERS AND STREAMS

. . .

- 1. Present a petition or request for changing of name of lake or stream to the County Board of Supervisors through your Township Supervisor.
- 2. After the County Board has received this petition or request, the County Clerk should cause a notice to be published in the local paper in the vicinity of the body of water stating that the Board will act on the petition or request at its meeting on a certain date. This should avoid unnecessary difficulties and delay in the event that the petition or request should receive the approval of the Board by having given all interested parties notification to appear and be heard on the advisability of the proposed name-change.
- 3. Have the County Board of Supervisors pass a resolution favoring and approving the proposed change in name. This resolution must mention each lake or stream separately, stating:
 - (a) Name or names by which the lake or stream is now known.

- (b) Location by section, township, and range.
- (c) The proposed name.
- (d) Reason that the proposed name is considered necessary or advisable.
- (e) Meaning of name (Why so named?).
- (f) Attach map or township plat and indicate the lake or stream affected.

This information must be furnished with accuracy and completeness in order to avoid confusion and misapplication of names.

- 4. Have the County Clerk send to R. A. Smith, State Geologist, Department of Conservation, Lansing, Michigan, a certified copy of the County Board of Supervisor's resolution of approval on the attached forms with map or township plat showing the particular lake or stream affected.
- 5. The State Committee on Geographic Names will then consider and act on the proposed name or names as approved in the County Board's resolution. If the State Committee concurs with the County Board in their action, that Committee will forward the certified copy of the County Board's resolution and map or plat, together with its recommendations, to the U. S. Geographic Board, Washington, D. C. for that Board's consideration. The action of the U. S. Geographic Board will be final. Their approval will assure the use of the proposed name or names on all future maps on which the place and feature names have official standing.
- 6. If the lake or stream lies partly in another county or counties, joint action should be taken by the counties concerned.
- 7. The U. S. Geographic Board will advise the State Committee as to the final and official decision on the proposed name changes. The State Committee will then transmit copies of that decision to the County Clerk and yourself or other interested persons.

*Author's suggestion—If the lake is small a more detailed description within the section should be given, e.g. (the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 14)

It would be desirable to stimulate local groups to greater activity in making name changes and clearing up the lake nomenclature of each county. This might very well be done through the Department of Conservation, whereby certain of the existing staff might be assigned to this task. Local sportsmen groups if properly instructed could go far in bringing about desirable name changes. Where large numbers of lakes are located in uninhabited areas and on public lands, name changes could be suggested by conservation employees directly to the County Board of Supervisors following ,of course, the desires

of local people if any exist. Conservation Officers and other Field

Administration personnel would be in a good position to further this plan.

Copies of these changes should be submitted to all state agencies who make or use maps and to county offices concerned. There is dire need of some editorial board to pass on state maps in order to prevent the gross errors of misspelling, omissions etc. which are perpetuated from map to map.
