SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

For every tenth sawlog tree, paint dots on one side of the tree to represent the number of 8' logs tallied. For every twentieth pulpwood tree, paint dots on one side of the tree to represent the total number of pulpwood sticks tallied. Stump marks are to be placed from the ground up one foot and clearly visible. Do not mark on rainy days or with snow around the stumps. Mark to create skid lanes where density is too close for mechanized equipment.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

- 1. Call Greg Gatesy at (989) 732-3541 ext 5441, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from (location).
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
