Avoid marking under-represented species(cherry, elm, birch, etc.) to serve as retention.

SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Individual stems within multiple stemmed clumps must either all be marked for removal or must all be left unmarked. Do not mark trees within 5' of the snowmobile trail. Do not mark Elm, Juneberry or Ironwood. Mark girdle trees with an orange "X" on both sides of tree. See administrator for marking instructions near stick nest.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Shannon Harig at (231) 238 9313 ext. 4742, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Indian River.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
