Stands with individual marked trees for retention do not need GPS traverse data for leave clumps (Stands 27, 64, 118, 129, 130 & 131). Instead, a GPS point should be taken to reflect these locations. Also, provide a GPS file with payment unit lines (yellow) splitting Stands 20 & 70 (in half running east - west), Stand 41 (in half running north - south) and Stand 97 (in approximately 3 equal size units running east - west).

GPS files must consist of individual files showing sale area, individual stand area, each payment unit area.

- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

- 1. Call Tim Greco at (989) 732-3541ex. 5443, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Gaylord field office.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- Tally summaries for each stand and/or payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
