Pigeon River Country Management Unit <u>Timber Cruising Specifications</u> <u>Phase I RPP</u>

- 1. Cruise at rate specified in the Timber Sale Preparation Prescription
- 2. Use a 10-factor prism.
- 3. Use the product standards to determine products and heights of products. Refer to product standards.
- 4. Mark location of plots on the map, using plot number.
- 5. Unless otherwise agreed to by the contract administrator and the contractor, plot center will be marked by a stake or stick firmly inserted in the ground (not snow) with a ribbon attached to it at a height of not less than two feet above the ground, and labeled with the stand number and plot number. In addition ribbon at least 12 inches long must be attached to a tree closest to plot center.
- 6. All cruise sheets must have the compartment #, stand #, prism factor, date individual tree species, and the cruiser's name.
