SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Individual stems within multiple stemmed clumps must either all be marked for removal or must all be left unmarked. Do not mark elm or juneberry. Mark girdle trees with an orange "X" on both sides of tree. Avoid marking under-represented species, they will be retained to maintain diversity. Marking specifications apply only to the hardwood stands (40 and 3). Red Pine (stand 39) will be marked to cut with 1 orange slash on opposite sides of the tree on all products.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Shannon Harig at (231) 238 9313 ext. 4742, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from (location).
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
