Stand 25 & 32: All Red Maple is to be removed and where needed mark Oak to cut with orange paint to retain 70 BA/AC. Stand 126: 2nd Stage Shelterwood cut. Mark to cut with orange paint retaining 30 BA/AC. Access: Via Mostetler Road and various state two tracks.

For all stands Michigan DNR retention guidelines must be followed. Contractor may be required to mark and GPS a minimum of 3% and a maximum of 10% of the stand area as retention. Retention may require marking leave trees with green paint, individually and/or in small groups. Implementation of the retention guidelines will be discussed on a stand by stand basis at the pre work meeting.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Mike Hanley at (517) 243 2028, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Gladwin field office.
- Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
