 Stand 31: Aspen and ash removal: do not mark these species. Mark additional trees with orange paint for removal where necessary to enable operability of equipment. 								
Stand 76: All Jack Pine will be retained. Mark to leave Oak to retain 10 BA/AC.								
Access: Via Deer Road, Grim Road and various state two tracks.

SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

For all stands Michigan DNR retention guidelines must be followed. See individual stand prescriptions for retention details. Contractor must GPS leave islands. Implementation of the retention guidelines will be discussed on a stand by stand basis at the pre work meeting.

Where possible focus retention along hiking trail in Stands 31 & 51. Portions of stand 31 are very wet. These wet areas, along the northern and eastern edges of the stand, can also be used for retention

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Mike Hanley at (517) 243 2028, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Gladwin field office.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- 3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
