				PRESCRIPTION				
 Mark stands to enhance existing white/red pine regeneration as well as encouraging new growth. Mark White and Red Pine to improve quality and growth of residual trees. Leave some large/wolfy white pine present in stand. Mark all cut trees with yellow paint. Mark stands so that it is maneuverable/operable for logging operations to occur. Mark only the paper birch and aspen that will present a maneuverability problem for logging. Retain some den/cavity trees if present, or retain potential trees if they are not present. Leave all oak within the stands. If stick nests are found leave a minimum 1 chain unmarked buffer around the nest tree and contact the Newberry field office for additional requirements. Access North of Newberry on M-123 to County Road 407. Take 407 north to Pine Stump Junction and turn on County Road 414. Travel County Road 414 for approximately 6 miles to the work area. SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

- -Two sided marking on all marked trees.
- -Tally all jack pine. The jack pine does not need to be marked, just tallied.
- -Mark the paper birch and aspen to be cut. Mark these trees to improve operability within the sale.
- -Dots will be painted on the pulp tally trees so they can be checked.
- -Mark all sawlog trees with an "X" with dots to correspond with the number of sawlogs tallied.
- -No need to paint red boundary line along County Road 414, the road will serve as the boundary.
- -If stick nests are found leave a minimum 1 chain unmarked buffer around the nest tree. Contact the Newberry field office for any additional requirements.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Keith Magnusson at (906) 293 3293, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from the Newberrry Field Office.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- 3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
