PRESCRIPTION

1. Favor (leave) the best future crop tree in place, regardless of species.
2. Do not mark any WP, WSp, or hemlock. Also, leave a pulpwood component of yellow and p. birch.
3. Leave a pulpwood component of beech.
4. Aspen and balsam fir do not need to be marked; they are designated as a cut species.
5. Mark stand to improve maneuverability within the stand for logging operations to occur.
6. Retain some den or cavity trees if present, or retain potential trees if not already present.
7. If stick nests are found leave a minimum 1 chain unmarked buffer around the nest tree and
8. contact the Newberry field office for additional requirements.

Cruise Special Instructions:

Cruise all marked hardwood pulp, paper birch pulpwood (keeping PB as a separate tally), aspen and balsam fir. Exact plot center will be marked by placing a stick in the ground, flagged with ribbon marked with corresponding plot number. If not much aspen and balsam fir are present, it may be counted by tally instead (see below). This can be discussed at the pre-work meeting.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those supplied by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Maintain stand diversity by leaving some beech, yellow and paper birch, and black cherry if present. Visual management must be considered along M-123 (scenic route). Do not mark trees that lean heavy towards the highway and would be difficult for the logger to fell.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

1. Call Newberry at (906) 293 - 3293, to make arrangements for paint.
2. Paint will be supplied from the Newberry Field Office.
3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
4. GPS files for any GPS work.
