#### SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Maintain stand diversity by leaving some beech, yellow and paper birch, and black cherry. Visual management must be considered along M-123 (scenic route). Do not mark trees that lean heavy towards the highway and would be difficult for the logger to fell.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

## **RESTRICTIONS**

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

#### **PAINT**

- 1. Call Newberry FMU at (906) 293 3293, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from the Newberry Field Office.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

### **DELIVERABLES**

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
