1) See Appendix for cruising instructions. 2) Each cruise plot must be identified on the ground. A map showing the location of these cruise plots must be turned in. Scale on map must be 1:15840. 3)Residual basal area by species must be tallied at each cruise plot. Borderline residual trees do not have to be measured, but every other borderline residual tree should be counted. 4) Species grouping: mixed hardwood pulpwood (maple, beech, and cherry pulpwood) and mixed aspen pulpwood(quaking & bigtooth). All other trees must be cruised by species. 5)No hemlock or oak will be cut. These species should be counted as residual basal area. **Cruise plots may decrease/increase depending on actual GPS acres.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those supplied by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Jeff Stampfly at (906) 452 6227 ext 240, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Shingleton.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- 3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.

Compartment 124 Phase II Contract TIMBER SALE PRESCRIPTION APPENDIX

When establishing paint lines:

- Avoid using dead or badly damaged trees boundary trees must last for the duration of the timber sale (up to 5-6 years).
- Favor the use of reserved species such as oak.
- Avoid using small (fast-growing) stems and those exposed to direct sunlight.

When Registered Corners or Witness Trees are discovered:

- Any wooden posts encountered at corners must also be painted/protected.
- Bearing and/or witness trees discovered during the course of sale preparation must be protected. This can be accomplished by painting a ring completely around the tree at 4-6 feet above ground level with either red paint (corner surrounded by state lands) or blue paint (corner on private property boundary line). In addition, tying ribbon on these trees helps alert loggers to their presence. Do not mark any trees for harvest if cutting them is likely to result in damage to corner monuments and/or bearing trees.
- Please report the condition of all corners, posts and bearing trees to the local contact.

When Cruising:

- Data must be recorded so volume can be determined by stand. If a stand is split into 2 or more payment units, each unit must be recorded separately. In addition, all data must be summarized by species or species grouping by payment unit.
- Within Stands 97-100, 409 and 410 cruise all species that will yield one or more 100"pulpwood sticks with a minimum top diameter of four (4) inches DIB. Residual basal area must be recorded at each plot by species. The Shingleton Unit does not separate sawlog products out of balsam fir, aspen, spruce or jack pine. Unless otherwise noted, cruise all species of sawlogs and pulpwood separately, cruise sawlog products to (10) inches DIB. The local contact will advise of species grouping at the on-site discussion.
- Plot centers must be marked according to contract specifications and correspond to a legible 1:15840 scale cruise map. Cruise specifications may be altered as necessary by the local contact.

Reserved Species:

- No oak or hemlock will be cut. Avoid marking other trees if harvesting them is likely to result in damage to this reserved species.
- Report the discovery of any raptor nest trees to the local contact as soon as possible and directions will be given at that time.

The contractor should contact Jeff Stampfly, Unit Manager, at the Shingleton Field Office, PO Box 67, M-28, Shingleton, MI 49884 (906) 452-6227 once the contract is awarded so a local contact can be assigned. Approximately 1 week prior to beginning work, the contractor will notify the Unit Manager or local contact to arrange an on-site meeting to discuss the details of these prescriptions. Paperwork should be completed and all of the necessary reports submitted to the Unit secretary as soon as possible after the fieldwork is complete, this includes the corrected GPS files.
