SPECIES TO FAVOR

Best tree in place in all categories. Good representatives of minor species should be left.

SPECIES TO FAVOR

Do not mark to cut,oak,hemlock,cedar or red or white pine.

SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Sawlog/large pulp tally sheets will be provided by the DNR and must be used. Sawlog trees will be marked with a slash on each side and dots on one side representing the number of logs tallied. Pulp trees will be marked with a slash on opposite sides of the tree.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Linda at (906) 875 6622, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from (location).
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- 3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- GPS files for any GPS work.

Many Helping Hands Sale (hardwood marking contract)

This sale is accessed through private lands. All landowners were contacted prior to lines being run and were informed that contract marking will be done on State lands. The contractor should make contact with the necessary landowners prior to crossing their property. All roads used for access should be treated with care. No debris of any kind is to be left on private or State lands.

Stands should be marked following the guidelines set forth in 'The Complete Marker: A Guide To Managing Northern Hardwoods On Michigan State Forests'.

Specifically, all stands on this sale should be left with a residual basal area of 70-90, with an overall average of 80 square feet per acre. Emphasis should be on releasing crop trees. Favor best tree in place regardless of species. Good representatives of minor species should be retained as well. Do not mark oak, red or white pine, hemlock or cedar.

Stands to be marked are bounded by red paint dots against State lands and blues dots against private. Stand 36, as shown on map 1 north of stand 35, is an aspen stand not included in this contract and is not to be marked. This stand is separated from stand 35 by red slash marks painted both sides of the boundary trees.

Sawlog tally sheets with space for tallying large pulp will be provided by the administrator and must be used to tally log sized pulp in sawlog trees. The administrator will explain the proper use of these forms if the contractor is unfamiliar with pulp log tallying. Cruise forms to be used will be at the discretion of the administrator.

Each sawlog tree will be marked with a slash on both sides and dots representing the number of sawlogs tallied on one side as well. Pulp trees must be marked with a slash on each side. Each tree is to have a stump mark reaching from approximately one foot up the stump and onto the ground. Paint will be provided by the administrator.

The contractor will notify the administrator upon entering/completing each stand so that the marking may be checked before the cruise is begun. Each stand must be cruised and all tally sheets and summaries, cruise sheets and cruise grids given to the administrator before proceeding with the next stand unless specific permission is given to do otherwise.
