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Cruise Special Instructions:

Establish semi-permanent plots. Plot center will be set with something like a wooden stake, rebar, PVC pipe or some other approved device. Stake must stick out at least 4" above the ground, be flagged, painted, numbered and easy to see. Numbering will start with 1 and end with 40. Additional flagging should be placed overhead so the plot may be easily located. All trees, whether 'cut' or 'leave', that are 'in' using a Limiting Distance Table with a Basal Area Factor of 10, will be marked and measured. Marking will consist of a horizontal line (about 6") at dbh and a tree number anywhere on the tree, but clearly visible from plot center. Tree number will start at 1 for each plot. Azimuth and distance to the center of the tree at the base from the plot center will be recorded along with species and dbh to the nearest 10th. DBH will be measured with a d-tape. On the 40 acre sub-sample area, every 4th tree "in" the point is marked (with a different color paint) with a unique ID# (a, b, c, etc); these are "sub-sample" trees. There can be no mistakes on 'in' and 'out' trees. When trees are near the edge of the stand, the 'walkthrough' method (Ducey et al 2004) will be used.

Stakes will be provided by the contractor. Aerosol paint will be supplied by the DNR.

Tally sheets will be provided by the contractor. Output from an electronic data recorder is acceptable.

SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Throop at (231) 775 9727, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Cadillac OSC.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in aerosol cans).
- 3. Tally summaries for each plot.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.

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
