<ol> <li>Mark stand 61 to reduce BA to an average of 80 sq.ft. using single tree selection/crop tree release marking.</li> <li>Due to BBD, mark out most rough barked beech. Favor leaving smooth barked beech for crop trees</li> <li>Mark out Ash with evidence of EAB or trees that appear high risk.</li> <li>Release pockets of advanced hardwood regeneration, where applicable.</li> <li>Leave minor species such as elm, hemlock, under-represented species, snags and den trees.</li> <li>On steep slopes, mark the draws and accessible ridge tops only, leave steep hills unmarked.</li> <li>Leave large trees suitable for raptors &amp; other wildlife.</li> <li>Protect trees with stick nests, and report to DNR.</li> <li>Mark out merchantable Aspen during single tree selection. All aspen adjacent to Stand 54 on upland slopes must be marked to resemble a clearcut along that narrow strip.</li> <li>A 4.5 acre aspen clearcut will be established for stand 59 at south end of treatment area. Refer to attached map and further specifications.</li> </ol>

For stand 61: Mark and tally logs 100%. Mark and point sample cruise all pulpwood. Sugar Maple, Red Maple, Birch, Beech, White Ash, and Black Cherry pulp can be combined as mixed hardwood pulp. All other pulp species, and Basswood and Aspen must be cruised separately. Residual BA must be tallied at each cruise point. Each sample point is to be recorded and clearly marked on the ground for the contract administrator to locate and review.

For stand 59: This stand can be point sample cruised without marking sawlogs. All species should be tallied to include estimates of both sawlogs & pulpwood. Each sample point is to be recorded and clearly marked on the ground to locate and review. Note: All hemlock will be left uncut.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those supplied by the Forest Resource Division Unit.

## SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Mark on both sides of the tree. On hills, marks should face the downward slope. Manage for the best tree in place, but favor leaving sugar maple and basswood for crop trees, and remove poorly formed and defective trees. Beech bark disease is in this compartment so mark out rough bark beech and leave smooth barked trees for residual crop trees. Some living den trees can also be left for wildlife. For sawlog trees, paint dots on one side of the tree only to represent the number of 8' logs tallied. The other side will be marked with an X. Stump marks are to be placed from the ground up one foot and clearly visible. Do not mark on rainy days or with snow around the stumps. With clump grown trees with multiple stems, treat it as one tree by marking entire clump or leaving entire clump. In stand 54: Do not mark any trees for harvest. This is a small lowland pocket that is seasonally wet and not included in the timber contract acreage.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

# **RESTRICTIONS**

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

### **PAINT**

- 1. Call Kimberly Lentz at (989) 732 3541 ext: 5442, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Gaylord Field Office.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

# **DELIVERABLES**

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- 3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- GPS files for any GPS work.
