PRESCRIPTION

1. Favor best tree in place-strive for 50 to 70 crop trees per acre.
2. Reduce basal area to 70 to 90 with 2-4 canopy gaps per acre.
3. Retain minor species components of the stand (ie. white spruce, y. birch, cherry)
4. Do not mark hemlock, cedar, white pine.
5. Mark in a manner that will accommodate mechanical harvesting.
6. Retain large legacy trees if present and 2 to 4 wildlife trees per acre (cavity and den trees).
7. Contact the Gwinn contract administrator for specific instructions prior to beginning.

SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Favor the best tree in place with emphasis on sugar maple, cherry, yellow birch. Retain most of the healthy cherry and yellow birch removing entire crown competition. Emphasis is on crop tree release. Pulp trees need a single slash or dot on both sides of the tree (opposite faces) above breast height. Sawlog trees will have a double slash on one side, and a single slash plus a dot for each 8 foot log tallied on the opposite side above breast height. Stump marks will extend from the ground up the stump at least 6 inches and be on bark, not moss or lichen. The trees will not be marked when the bark is wet.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

1. Call Kevin LaBumbard at (906) 346 - 9201, to make arrangements for paint.
2. Paint will be supplied from (the Gwinn field office).
3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
4. GPS files for any GPS work.
