 Mark trees to be cut. Favor the best future crop tree in place, regardless of species. Leave den and nest trees and let administrator know if you find a nest tree. Retain all hemlock, oak, cedar and red and white pine. Release oak to promote regeneration if present, 1-2 tree lengths from drip line. GPS all roads within the sale area and GPS corners also. Thin to 80 BA. If there are hemlock areas, just leave all of them according to administrator. Remove trees by marking if they have cankers or seams. For selection cut mark 2 to 3- 30 foot canopy gaps per acre. This happens by removing large crowned trees and cleaning out the area that will be left after the tree is cut for regeneration Cut all aspen, spruce and balsam with a stump diameter of 6 inches or greater. Thin to 80 BA leaving the best future crop tree in place.
