PRESCRIPTION

- Mark stands 4,11,22 & 68 to reduce BA to an average of 80 sq.ft. using single tree selection/crop tree release marking.
- 2. Favor basswood and maple using 7 foot crown release guidelines for crop trees.
- 3. Due to BBD, mark out most of rough barked beech. Favor leaving a minor component of smooth barked beech for mast & crop trees. Leave minor species such as elm, hemlock, under represented species, snags and den trees.
- 4. Leave large trees suitable for raptors & other wildlife.
- 5. Protect trees with stick nests, and report to DNR.

CONTRACT WORK MUST BE COMPLETED BY Date 09/01/2013

- 6. Mark out merchantable Aspen during single tree selection. Leave some Aspen suitable for living den trees.
- 7. Protect steep slopes which are mostly in the south end of stand 68. On steep slopes, mark the draws and accessible ridge tops only, leave steep hills unmarked.
- 8. Mark out all Ash in an effort to salvage with EAB in the area.
- 9. In the east part of stand 68 is a hiking trail. Protect by leaving an unmarked buffer of 30'on both sides. Provide at least two locations for logger to cross trail when marking.

Mark and tally logs 100% by species. Mark and point sample cruise all pulpwood. Sugar Maple, Red Maple, Black Cherry, yellow birch pulp can be combined as mixed hardwood pulp. All other pulp species, basswood, beech, aspen, & ash must be cruised separately. Residual BA must be tallied at each cruise point. Each sample point is recorded and clearly marked on the ground for the contract administrator to locate and review.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those supplied by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

SPECIAL MARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Mark on both sides of the tree. On hills, marks should face the downward slope. Manage for the best tree in place, but favor leaving basswood and sugar maple for crop trees, and remove poorly formed and defective trees. Beech bark disease is a concern in this compartment, so mark out rough bark beech and leave smooth barked trees for mast & crop trees. EAB is also evident & all Ash should be salvaged. Some living den trees should also be left for wildlife. For sawlog trees, paint dots on one side of the tree only to represent the number of 8' logs tallied. The other side will be marked with an \mathbf{X} . Stump marks are to be placed from the ground up one foot clearly visible. Do not mark on rainy days or with snow around the stumps. With clump grown trees with multiple stems, treat it as one tree by marking entire clump or leaving entire clump.

Unless otherwise specified, the tally sheets used must be those provided by the Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Unit.

RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Forest, Mineral and Fire Management Division must to be able to identify who did what on the timber sale.
- 2. The contractor may not have more than two markers in one payment unit without prior approval.
- 3. Each marker should have an assigned area to mark (not strips).

PAINT

- 1. Call Kimberly Lentz at (989) 732 3541 ext: 5442, to make arrangements for paint.
- 2. Paint will be supplied from Gaylord DNR Field Office. Upon being awarded contract, notify DNR representative whether paint will be needed in quarts or gallons.
- 3. Contractor's work schedule must coincide with the DNR work schedule for paint supply.
- 4. The DNR will not be available on weekends or evenings.

DELIVERABLES

- 1. A list of names that marked or cruised each payment unit.
- 2. A summary of paint used (in quarts).
- 3. Tally summaries for each payment unit (one summary, regardless of the number of markers) and all of the original tally sheets.
- 4. GPS files for any GPS work.
