### **Species Description**

Brown trout are rarely caught by anglers but steelhead may be caught in winter and spring months.

#### **Noteworthy**

This site is located in the Allegan State Game Area, a public tract of land that provides 50,000 acres to recreational users. This site also provides access to the Kalamazoo River and Ottawa Marsh for non-fishing recreational opportunities.

# **Fishing Regulations**

Kalamazoo River is not a designated trout stream in this area. Anglers can catch brown trout and rainbow trout/steelhead that are stocked in the river and tributary streams. Regulations for Streams Not Classified as Stream Type or Listed as a Gear Restricted Stream regulations in the current Michigan Fishing Guide.

#### **Directions to Site**

Traveling north on M-89 in the city of Allegan, turn left (west) onto Monroe Road (118th Avenue) and proceed 7 miles to the area headquarters. Access is located in the Allegan State Game Area just upstream from the Ottawa Marsh. This is a sandy access site limited to small watercraft or canoes/kayaks. Parking is limited to a few vehicles and there is no boat launch with skid pier.
