Comments from stakeholders received prior to Compartment Review

The Open House was held on September 5th, 2023. Two people from the public attended. One written comment was received the day before the Compartment Review relating to State Forest treatments. Public comments were received regarding.

- Concerns about the lack of consideration of BMPs in some stands.
- Concerns about splitting of the Crystal Falls Unit and the ability of the public to participate in the compartment review process.
- General comments the need to flag stands within or adjacent to deer wintering complexes or condition critical cover.
- General comments regarding the lack of specific wildlife comment section.
- Lack of maps showing purchased lands.
- Specific comments for stands in compartments 15, 31, 45, 94, 113, 150, 162, and 163; regarding use of BMPs, 2" cutting specs, lack of cutting in some compartments, lack of specific specs in treatment proposal, and Use of the Complete Marker as a spec.
