Compartment 27 - Stand Examiner Steve Nyhoff

Treatments on Stand 47 and 52: Add language to protect trees with trail signs and/or confidence paint and to keep equipment off the trail.

Treatment on Stand 33: Add comment that M2M trail runs on road on east side and MCCCT runs on road on south side. Add language to keep the trails clear of debris, to protect trees with trail signs and/or confidence paint and to keep equipment off the trails. All approved

Compartment 124 - Stand Examiner Steve Nyhoff

Treatment on Stand 88: FRD Forest Health staff confirmed that red pine mortality was due to armillaria so proposal to cut and plant red pine can proceed as planned. All approved

Midland-Isabella Management Area

Compartment 106 – Stand Examiner Scott Shooltz

Add label for Pine Haven Recreation Area to maps.

Change trail symbology for trails within Pine Haven Recreation Area from "Designated Hiking Trails" to "Non-designated Recreational Trail" to show that they are managed by a different group under a lease with the DNR.

Proposed Special Conservation Area for Pine Haven should be for the SCA Category of "Concentrated Recreation Area" with Detail Type of "Trail - Trail Corridor." Eliminate duplicate SCA for "Contiguous Resource Area." Resolve data issue that is publishing report with "Error." Remove symbology for Rail Trail Corridor from SCA map. All approved
