Compartment 003 (Stand Examiner – John St. Pierre)


Add horse trail symbol to the map.

Stand 45 – Add treatment; clearcut with retention.

Compartment 048 (Stand Examiner – Greg Rekowski)

Stands 5, 12, 32, 39, 43, 45 – Modify treatments from burning to general maintenance to include burning.

Edit SCA to remove a portion of a cold-water stream segment that doesn't exist on the ground (T31N, R01W, Sec. 11 & 14).

Stand 53 – Add MCCCT motorcycle specs.

Compartment 027 (Stand Examiner – Jake Halabut)
