Be aware: Kinney WPA, and the adjacent cooperating Cornish SGA have special local rules for parking, for limits on type of boats used on Grass Lake, and shot restrictions (non-toxic). See details to the right.

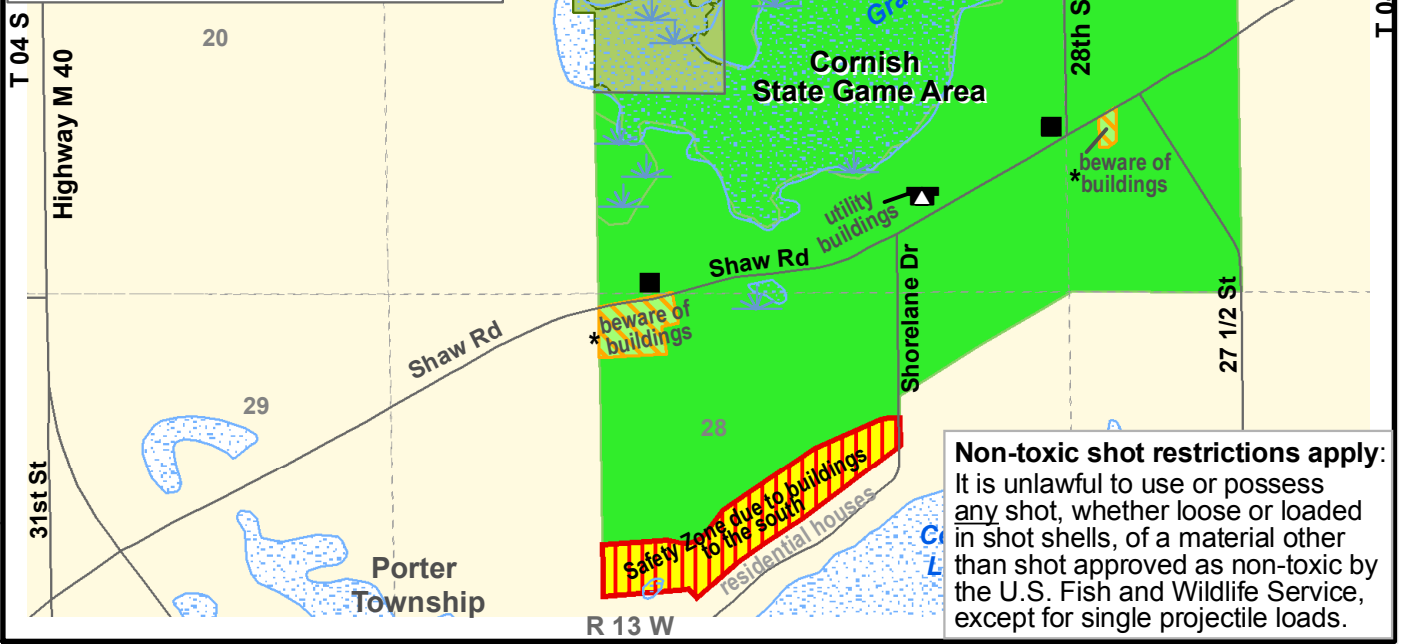
Park only in designated areas. This area is surrounded by private land. Side-street or informal parking along any of the roads can cause public safety hazards. Please respect these land owners' rights, their access to/from their own lands by not blocking access, and by respecting property edges, posted signs, and safety zones. If you have questions, please contact the area office listed above.

Limit on watercraft types used on Grass Lake:
No watercraft with motors, except those with electric motors, may be used in the area. Grass Lake is shallow, very vegetated, and using motorized water craft can cause damage.

Waterfowl Production Areas (WPAs) are Federal lands managed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) in partnership and cooperation with the Michigan DNR Wildlife Division.

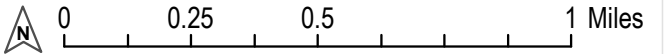

Non-toxic shot restrictions apply:
It is unlawful to use or possess any shot, whether loose or loaded in shot shells, of a material other than shot approved as non-toxic by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, except for single projectile loads.

- * Shown in the map: beware of buildings, and that these are not valid parking areas.



Important!: 150 yards or 450 feet Safety Zones (No Shooting!) are enforced around all buildings and structures at all times. Be Safe! Always be careful around water and ditch/dikes for deep water!

Look for Watchable Wildlife viewing area signs in this area, for locations and more information about trails or features.
